Watch as Rahab thwarts Jericho's authorities and saves the life of two Hebrew spies.

Read it

Joshua 2:1-16
 Matthew 1:1, 5
 Hebrews 11:31
 James 2:14, 25

Live it

Take this opportunity to remind students that it is through faith that people are saved, regardless of their past or reputation. But explain that faith doesn't just stand by and watch; like Rahab, it jumps on board with God's plan and acts. Further, explain that the story of Rahab teaches that God can and will use anyone regardless of past sins. Encourage students that a prostitute finding her way into the lineage of Jesus Christ (see Matthew 1:1,5) is a perfect demonstration that all people are precious and worthy to be used by God.

Discuss it

~What was so amazing about Rahab protecting the spies?

~Think about how God worked through various people in Scripture. How is God's choice to include a prostitute in His plan similar to how God used David, Moses, Paul and others?

~Rahab wasn't an Israelite, so what does the Hebrews passage tell us about salvation in the Old Testament?

~How is Rahab's story similar to how God offers salvation today?
